Surprisingly, quite a few people would choose option one overleaf. They see homelessness as self inflicted or feel that it can't be that hard to 'sort yourself out and get a job'.

Such attitudes are mainly the result of a lack of understanding of the real issues that relate to homelessness. After all, no one would seriously suggest that the ex-army officer who was forced to seek help from Julian House did so out of choice. He did so because we were his only option. A far cry from officers' mess functions and salutes from his soldiers.

He is just one of the 400 men and women who stayed in the Julian House night shelters during the last year. Although for some the harsh realities of homelessness last just a few days, for most the journey back from the streets is much longer and more difficult.

Providing a bed is the relatively easy bit. Much more challenging for the staff at Julian House is identifying why our clients are in this position and then finding appropriate solutions – to reconnect these desperate men and women back into mainstream society. This is why our other projects are so important - Supporting Housing, Meaningful Occupation, the Community Support Team, Women's Refuge, Outreach Service and access to Primary Health Care.
