

Volunteering Opportunities

Evening Volunteer - Julian House Hostel for the Homeless

This role provides volunteers with the opportunity to serve the evening meal to, and chat with, the homeless people staying at Julian House's 20 bed, 24 hour hostel. You will provide the finishing touches to a meal prepared by volunteers on our afternoon shift. There are 3 separate volunteer shifts at our hostel. The evening shift starts at 7pm and finishes at 9pm, Monday to Sunday. We aim to have 2 volunteers in the kitchen for each shift.

Skills and Qualifications Required

You will need to have some basic cooking ability, along with good communication skills and a non-judgmental attitude.

Skill Development

This role provides the opportunity for you to improve your communication skills as you meet and interact with the homeless men and women who use our services.

Directions

Julian House Hostel is in the centre of Bath, in Manvers Street, in between the Police station and Bath Spa Railway Station. The entrance is down the stairs next to Manvers Street Baptist church.

Other Information

Volunteers must be at least 18 years old.

Volunteers will receive support from the Hostel Support Workers and the Julian House Volunteer Coordinator.

Volunteers should be prepared to commit to at least 2 sessions per month and we would prefer this commitment to continue for at least 6 months.

In doing this job you will have a key role within our organisation. We rely on the support of our volunteers to enable us to provide evening meals for the homeless men and women who stay with us.
